Registered Queensland teachers are eligible for nomination. The major award prize in this category will be a \$5000 grant for professional development. Finalists will receive a \$500 grant for professional development.

Who is eligible for nomination?

Teachers including early childhood teachers, heads of department, heads of curriculum, heads of special education services, deputy principals and principals may be nominated.

Nominated teachers must be registered with the QCT and must be employed in teaching duties in one of the following:

- a Queensland state school
- a Queensland non-state school
- a Queensland early childhood setting delivering the QCAA *Kindergarten Learning Guideline* or *C&K Building Waterfalls* kindergarten guideline.

Endorsement by principal or other education official

Nominations must be supported by a statement from the school principal or employer confirming the bona fides of the nominator's response to the criteria. Another education official should provide a statement to verify the bona fides of a nomination by or of a principal or employer.

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Nomination tips

- The nomination will be judged solely on the basis of achievements and other evidence listed in the supporting statement.
- List achievements and other evidence to demonstrate excellence in teaching.
- Describe how the listed achievements prepare young people to lead successful and productive lives.
- Write clearly on the lines below or attach a one-page response.
- Do not include lesson plans, copies of certificates or other documents.

Supporting statement

Nominator to respond to the following criteria. Nominee may clarify achievements.

1. Draws on a body of professional knowledge and research to respond to the needs of students in his/her educational context.

2. Makes learning engaging and valuable, and operates effectively at all stages of the teaching and learning cycle.

3. Demonstrates commitment to learning, and professionalism in all interactions with students, colleagues, parents/carers and the community.

Nominator

The following individuals or groups may nominate a teacher:

- teaching colleagues or school administrators
- school parents and citizens or parents and friends committees
- parents, students or other members of school / service communities.
