A principal / employer from a school where the nominated teacher has practised must endorse the nomination and confirm some knowledge of the nominee's teaching and achievements. Another education official / employer should endorse the nomination of a principal / service director.

Eligibility

- Teachers including early childhood teachers, heads of department, heads of curriculum, heads of special education services, deputy principals and principals may be nominated.
- Nominees must be registered with the QCT.
- Nominees must have served a minimum of 15 years in Queensland schools or early childhood settings delivering the *QCAA Kindergarten Learning Guideline* or *C&K Building Waterfalls kindergarten guideline*, but need not be currently employed in a school / service.
- One of the nominators must be a registered teacher or qualified education colleague.
- Self-nominators are not eligible.
- QCT Board members and staff are not eligible for nomination.

Criteria

The Courier-Mail Professor Betty H Watts OBE Memorial Award for an Outstanding Contribution to Teaching is aimed at recognition of special qualities including:

- an outstanding contribution to teaching over an extended period
- a proven record of inspiring children to learn
- a minimum of 15 years' teaching in a Queensland school / service.

Terms and conditions

Nomination forms must be signed by the nominee, nominator and principal / employer.

Completed nomination forms can be scanned and submitted in PDF file format via email to excellence@qct.edu.au.

Nominations will be acknowledged via email. Information about finalists and nominees, and their images, may be published on the QCT website and/or in external publications. Information about individuals as it relates to the promotion of the awards, the individual's school or service provider and the teaching profession will be considered for publication. Contact information provided may be used for administration and media purposes.

The judges' selections will be deemed final and appeals will not be considered.
